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Introduction

Inspired by the steering wheels of the most iconic classic cars and fabricated with the latest technology in the watchmaking world, the Twenty-One is a stunning modern take on classic style.

At the heart of this new-generation REBELLION watch is an automatic in-house movement. The hour is read at 12 o'clock. A 12-numbered disc rotates clockwise to move the correct hour smoothly into place while a specially shaped hand rotates in a traditional manner to reveal the minutes. Two smaller dashboard displays, at 4 o'clock and 8 o'clock respectively, display the seconds and a second time-zone indicator.

The complex movement is completed with a unique REBELLION finish. With 42 hours of power reserve, it is the perfect blend of classic car style, fine watchmaking and high-tech processes.

The Case

Classic yet modern. The vintage square case with rounded edges is made of stainless steel, and is the perfect finishing touch to such a refined yet masculine piece.

The Movement

This Swiss made, in-house movement is a true REBELLION creation reminiscent of old-timers, down to the last detail. Automatic. Like the beat of a heart, the oscillations of the movement's balance wheel keeps time. Inspired by the mechanical counters in classic cars, a complex construction of discs and subdials work together to indicate the time. A rotating hour disc and minute hand work together to display the time while two subdials reveal the seconds and a GMT indicator. Engineered with modern technology, it has a power reserve of 42 hours.

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Displays and Functions

Preparing to Set the Watch

The crown featured on your Twenty-One offers excellent protection against the penetration of water and moisture into the case. To prepare the watch for setting the time, unscrew the crown counter-clockwise. Once it cannot be unscrewed anymore, it is in position 1 and ready to be set.



Winding the Watch

Your Twenty-One is wound automatically by your wrist movements. When it is fully wound and off your wrist, your timepiece has a power reserve of 42 hours. If your watch has not been worn for some time, it must be wound manually. To wind your watch, unscrew the crown position 1 and turn the crown clockwise approximately 65 revolutions or until you feel a light resistance. Your watch is fully wound. Return the crown to home position.



Setting the Second Time-Zone

Completely unscrew the watch into position 1 and then pull it out one click so that the crown is in position 2. Turn the crown clockwise until your second time-zone indicator (located at 8 o'clock) shows the correct hour. (Beware: changing the time will simultaneously change the second time-zone. We suggest always setting the second time-zone first.) Return the crown to home position.

Setting the Time

Completely unscrew the watch into position 1 and then pull it out two clicks so that the crown is in position 3. Turn the crown clockwise until the hour disc and minute hand show the correct time. (Beware: changing the time will simultaneously change the second time-zone. We suggest always setting the second time-zone first.) Return the crown to home position.



Returning the Crown to Home Position

After each adjustment, ensure that the crown has been correctly returned to the home position by simultaneously pushing and screwing the crown in a clockwise direction until you feel resistance. We recommend regularly checking to ensure that the crown has been correctly and securely returned to the home position.



Changing the Bracelet

To change the bracelet of your Twenty-One, look at the timepiece with its back facing up. Place the bracelet at a 30 degree angle from the watch back, so that it lines up with the metal opening; pull on the metal piece of the bracelet. To reattach, place the bracelet at a 30 degree angle to the watch and push until you hear it click into place. (Beware: pull and push only using the metal of the bracelet, as pulling from any other part may damage the bracelet.)

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Care and Maintenance:

For best care of your watch we advise:

- Clean your watch regularly with a gentle microfibre tissue to keep it in optimal condition.
- Avoid contact with water or sweat to prevent premature ageing of your leather strap.
- After immersion in chlorinated or salty water, rinse it in freshwater and leave it to dry completely.
- Avoid placing your timepiece anywhere where it might be subjected to major variations in temperature or humidity (e.g. sauna), or direct sunlight. Do not expose your watch to extreme temperatures (e.g. behind a car glass for long periods). Your watch's movement is designed to function ideally in temperatures ranging from 0°C to 50°C.
- Avoid placing your timepiece near strong magnetic fields (e.g. speakers, electrical motors, etc.) as they can affect the running of your timepiece.
- Avoid any contact with abrasives, hazardous gases, solvents, detergents, mosquito repellent, sun creams, perfumes, cosmetic products, or other chemical products as they may damage the watch case, the strap, the glass or synthetic parts of your watch.
- Avoid any type of shocks to your watch. In the event that your watch is exposed to any violent impact or shock, have your watch checked by REBELLION Timepieces immediately.
- Never use your watch's pushers, wind the watch or adjust time/date when the watch is wet or has had any contact with water. We recommend this to avoid water penetration, even if your timepiece is

water resistant. This is to minimize risk of water entering the case and being exposed to moisture.

- Check if the crown is securely returned to the home position after each adjustment to prevent any water intrusion.
- We also recommend that you never adjust the date function between 8pm and 3am of a REBELLION timepiece as it could seriously damage the movement.

HAVING YOUR WATCH SERVICED

To ensure the running of your watch, we advise regular service and maintenance by our workshop at REBELLION Timepieces S.A. As with any racing car, the exclusive motor of your timepiece needs regular servicing in order to function to its fullest potential. We advise you to have your watch serviced at least once every 3 to 5 years by our workshop at REBELLION Timepieces S.A. We suggest you to take your watch to an Authorized REBELLION Timepieces Retailer who will send it to our workshop where it will be inspected and analyzed by our watchmakers. During your watch's maintenance, the case and the movement will be completely disassembled, cleaned lubricated and reassembled. Then rigorous accuracy calibrations and water resistance tests will be performed. Upon request, the case and the buckle will be refinished and polished. The full process takes several weeks because each watch must pass several tests to ensure REBELLION Timepieces' quality spirit.

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Water Resistance:

Your Twenty-One is 50 meters (5atm) water resistant. Water resistance cannot be guaranteed indefinitely. In case of intensive use underwater, annual pressure tests are recommended. Under normal conditions, we recommend testing every year. The pressure test takes only a few minutes and can be performed at any official center for REBELLION Timepieces or by an Authorized Retailer.
